


Glyn Abbey Golf Club Committee 2017 - 2018

The committee of the golf club is elected annually, usually at the Annual General Meeting which is held in late February. The term of office is for one year, or until the next AGM, if a committee member has been elected or co-opted onto the committee after the AGM. As Glyn Abbey Golf Club is a proprietor owned club the duties of the committee are different to those of a Members Owned Golf Club. The management of the course, the clubhouse and the facilities remain the responsibility of the club management company.


The members of the committee for the season 2017 - 2018 and their roles and responsibilities are outlined below.


	<p>CLUB CAPTAIN – David Hewer</p> <p>The Club Captain is the chairman of the committee and represents the club externally and internally on all matters relating to the Golf Club and social activities. Dave was elected as Club Vice-Captain last year. As Captain he organises the Captain's Day open competition and the end of season Presentation Evening. He will also take over or delegate any unfilled position on the committee. Traditionally the club captain also takes on a small project which will enhance the Course or facilities. 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	<p>VICE CAPTAIN – Laurence Jackman</p> <p>Laurence was nominated by Dave to act as his Vice Captain for this season and was elected at the AGM to this post. As the name suggests he will stand in for the Captain where necessary. It was decided some years ago that the Vice-Captain would chair a sub-committee for the organisation of the Dai Gravell Charity event which is held in August this year. This is the Club's main charity event and over the years has raised substantial amounts of money for a variety of charities in memory of one of the founding members of the club. 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	<p>TREASURER – Nigel Furneaux</p> <p>Nigel was nominated and elected at the AGM to this post. The Treasurer has responsibility for all monies generated by the Club through membership fees, competitions, fund raising, etc. He is also responsible for ensuring that prize money is distributed back to the management for both prize vouchers in the pro shop and, in the case of the “2's” competitions, funds being uploaded onto the players’ club cards. 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	<p>SECRETARY – Derek Baker.</p> <p>The Secretary’s responsibilities include the general administration of the Club activities, ensuring that the Club complies with the Constitution and administration of Committee affairs. He maintains minutes and other records as appropriate and arranges the publication of these. The Secretary is the Club’s representative on the Dyfed Golf Union. If any member has any complaints, comments or suggestions about the Members' Club they should contact the Secretary in the first instance. 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	<p>COMPETITION SECRETARY – Del Allen</p> <p>The Competition Secretary manages the organisation and running of Club competitions.
